HOW TO PARTICIPATE AS AN ABSENTEE BUYER

We have made preparations to bid and buy livestock through Superior Productions' "Call or Click-To-Bid" service for those unable to attend in person on sale day. Please note that all of the lots in the sale will also be available for viewing online prior to sale day at WWW.SUPERIORLIVE.COM.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

TURN IN BIDS OVER THE PHONE:

This is our traditional method of buying livestock. To get started simply go online to WWW.SUPERIORLIVE.COM and click on the tab titled "Register For Your Buyer's Number". Print the registration form, fill it out and fax it in (817-378-3380) to Superior Productions with a signature on it. You can also mail it in to the address provided on the form. Upon receipt of this information Superior will call you with a buyer's number and the bid line phone number that you will use on sale day to place bids over the phone.

CLICK-TO-BID:

This is Superior's newest way to buy livestock! Registration is free, but you must become a member of WWW.SUPERIORCLICKTOBID.COM to sign up. Becoming a member is easy - just go to the homepage of WWW.SUPERIORCLICKTOBID.COM and follow the outlined steps to get started. Input your information and select a username and password. You will receive an e-mail confirming you are a member. From that point forward you just have to sign in and select the sale you would like to register for and once approved by the ranch you will receive an e-mail confirming which sale you are now registered for.

VIEWING THE AUCTION:

The sale will be broadcast via satellite on Dish Network channel 231 and DirecTV channel 345. The sale will also be broadcast live on the internet at WWW.SUPERIORCLICKTOBID.COM - just go to the home page and select the auction. Remember you can call in to bid whether you watch on the TV or on the internet, but you must be a member of WWW.SUPERIORCLICKTOBID.COM to "click-to-bid". Your computer must have Flash Media Player installed to view the auction.

Bidders who are successful in making purchases via satellite or internet will be contacted by the ranch after the sale to settle payment and make shipping arrangements.

Terms and Conditions of Sale

1. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder. If any dispute arises between two or more bidders, the sole authority to settle the dispute is the auctioneer. The auctioneer also reserves the right to reject any bid.
2. When a horse is sold, the buyer shall sign the Acknowledgement of Purchase. The buyer shall pay for all animals prior to or at the conclusion of the sale.
3. Terms for the sale are cash, money order, cashiers check or personal check. There is a \$50.00 charge for returned checks. In addition the cost of collection, including attorney's fees, will be assessed to the buyer.
4. Buyers who are AQHA members will pay the \$15.00 transfer fee. AQHA transfer fee for non-members is \$55.00.
5. All registration papers will be held until the total purchase price has been paid and checks have cleared the bank. At such time papers and transfers fees will be mailed to the AQHA for transfer to the new owners. Buyers may select the names for foals at the time of sale or within 7 days of purchase.
6. Every effort has been made to insure statements in this catalog to be correct. Most of the information is taken from AQHA record; however, the auctioneer, sales manager or Rasmussen Quarter Horses Production Sale does not accept responsibility for error.
7. All known conditions, quality, soundness and blemishes will be announced: however, this does not imply any guarantee.

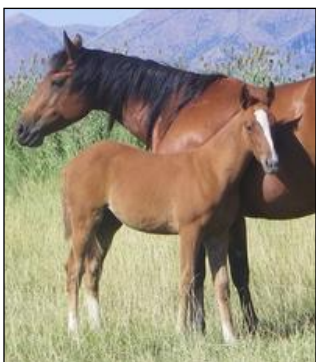
